

Guidance for Casual Badminton Bookings in **Tier 3** (Covid-19)

We are very pleased to be able to welcome casual users of our Badminton Courts back to the Leisure Centre. We are committed to the safe reopening of our facilities and until further notice have implemented the below actions and preventative measures to help mitigate the spread of Covid-19.

Badminton Courts

We are happy to accept casual badminton court bookings and have put the following procedures in place in line with Badminton England's published guidelines for play whilst in the tier 3 Covid alert level in an attempt to keep all of our hirers and staff as safe as possible:

- **Bookings for badminton courts can be made for singles and doubles whilst in tier 3. Everyone playing must be from the same household.**
- Court bookings can be made for any day of the week, but can only be booked to start at 30 minutes past the hour. For example a court can be booked for 6:30pm but not 6:00pm. This is to prevent a cross over with other Centre bookings and activities.
- Court bookings are limited to 50 minutes to allow a 10 minute gap between bookings.
- Bookings open from the day before at 11am. For example, if you wish to book for 4:30pm on Saturday you will be able to book this from 11am the day before.
- Where possible all bookings should be made via telephone: **0118 9216969**
- The main hirer (the person booking the court) must know the names and contact details of all players taking part in the court booking.
- It is the responsibility of the main hirer to hold the names and contact details of all players for 21 days to enable compliance with a potential NHS track and trace request.
- Where all players are under the age of 18 years one adult will be allowed to accompany the players into the facility and stay for the duration of the booking.
- Please ensure that you arrive promptly for your court booking. Customers who arrive late and miss their pre visit briefing may be refused entry to the facility.

It is the responsibility of the main hirer to hold the names and contact information of everyone who attended for a period of 21 days to enable compliance with a potential NHS track and trace request.

What's changed?

Court bookings will operate a little differently from before. Here are just a handful of the actions we have taken to help prevent the spread of Covid-19:

- When arriving for a court booking all customers must wait outside the front doors of the Leisure Centre on the patio area. A member of staff will greet you and guide you through a pre visit briefing to explain how your booking will work.
- QR codes that link to the NHS track and trace app are on display throughout the Centre.
- Hand sanitiser stations have been installed inside the Leisure Centre. All badminton court hirers will be required to sanitise their hands before entering the Sports Hall.
- Social distancing and Covid-19 awareness material is on display throughout the Leisure Centre. Social distancing must be adhered to at all times.
- Only courts one, two, four and five will be in use for casual badminton. Court 3 will remain out of action to allow a clear space for entry and exit to the Sports Hall.
- Benches have been positioned in specific locations at the front and back of each badminton court to help encourage social distancing between games.
- Centre staff will clean and disinfect Sports Hall benches before each booking.
- Hirers are strongly encouraged to wash and / or sanitise their hands prior to visiting the facility and after returning home following a booking.
- Hirers must bring their own rackets and shuttles / balls. Equipment should be sanitised at home prior to attending a booking and at home after attending a booking.
- Please bring enough water with you to last for the duration of your booking.
- No changing or shower facilities will be available within the Leisure Centre until further notice. Hirers are advised to arrive to the Leisure Centre ready to play.

Please do not attend your court booking if you are showing any symptoms of Coronavirus or have been in close contact with anyone that has (please visit the NHS website for more information on the symptoms of Coronavirus if you are unsure).
